

"The History"



In 1992 the eastern part of the site became an extension of the Point Cook Regional Park known as the Cheetham Wetlands whilst the western part situated within the City of Wyndham was cleared for commercial use and later became the basis of the Resort

"The Construction"

- The building of Sanctuary Lakes Resort commenced in 1995
 - It contains 2950 housing Lots plus a commercial precinct
- Fill was imported to ensure the land is above the 100 year flood level
 - The manmade lake is the largest in Melbourne
- •The Greg Norman designed golf course was opened in February 2000 by the Premier of Victoria, Steve Bracks, and Greg Norman

Sanctuary Lakes Resort - Development of the Site

The infrastructure of the Resort was finished in 2011 with the completion of the main boulevard ring road – Residents took control of the Board of SLRS Ltd in 2013





The Mosaic is held together through a delegation of authority given in a management contract to SLRS Ltd - a management company owned by all of the Owners Corporations



SLRS – The Company

- Is a Not-for-Profit Organisation whose owners are the 43 Owners Corporations within Sanctuary Lakes Resort
- Created to provide services to all Lot Owners at a common cost per lot
- Major role is administration and maintenance
- Employs 34 managers and staff
- Contracts out some key services
- Acts under a delegation of authority from all OCs to represent their interests in nominated areas including unilaterally enforcing OC rules across the Resort, billing & debt collection





SLRS - Vision Statement


To maintain a high quality residential lifestyle through:

- Developing and encouraging a strong community spirit






Sanctuary Lakes Resort - Business Model






Legal Roles and Responsibilities
