We are pleased to advise the new NBN Ready Alarm systems are available for installation.

With NBN being rolled out and changes from old telephone technology to new telephone technology, your alarm system will no longer be able to be monitored when the copper network is switched off in 2020.

There are two upgrade options available with installation by a qualified technician costing between \$160 and \$330.

We thank Ms Hennessy and Cr McAliney for making the time to be shown around Sanctuary Lakes Resort.



### **City West Water Works**

The Sanctuary Lakes vacuum sewer operates differently to the gravity sewerage system that services most of City West Water's area. The system needs a degree of special care to operate reliably. Due to the flat ground and relatively high underground water levels at Sanctuary Lakes, this development has been provided with a vacuum sewerage system.

To ensure the system keeps pace with the area's rapidly growing population, City West Water is constructing a new sewer main from the pump station adjacent to Vaucluse Boulevard through the Sanctuary Lakes Golf Course to Spinnaker Rise.
