SUBURB UPDATE: COUNCIL MEETING TONIGHT

Wyndham City Council Councillors will vote at tonight's Meeting on whether Sanctuary Lakes should be recognised as a suburb separate to Point Cook.

The meeting agenda, released at 5pm on Friday, contains a recommendation from Council staff on this topic. The recommendation is that Councillors vote against Sanctuary Lakes becoming a suburb, despite 84.5% of respondents supporting the suburb proposal.

DUNNING'S RD & PALMERS RD WORKS UPDATE

Construction for the site compound for the Dunning's Rd and Palmers Rd Upgrade Project, will begin at the end of June. It is expected to take 4 weeks to complete. Construction work will take place Monday to Fridays between 7am and 6pm, and Saturdays 7am-1pm. The Western Roads Upgrade Team has advised that there may be traffic disruption, so please allow extra time for travel if you use these roads.



UNATTENDED FISHING LINES

Please note that it is illegal to leave fishing lines unattended. If you do see an unattended fishing line, or see wildlife trapped or injured due to fishing lines, please contact Security on 9394 9477. We also ask that residents avoid feeding wildlife, as it can negatively impact their health and increase conditions such as 'angel wings' in birds. Thank you.



ADOPT A FIRE HYDRANT

Help us help our local emergency services by "adopting" a fire hydrant and keeping it clear from grass, plants, soil and other things which may restrict access. You can identify if your property has a hydrant on or near it by the red topped white marker poles, and blue reflective markers on the road near the hydrant cover (usually a metal plate set into the ground).

CREEPY CRAWLIES

Almost every house, garage and shed in Sanctuary Lakes has been a comfortable shelter to numerous species of Native Australian Spiders, especially now, as the weather begins to cool towards winter and the spiders seek warmth indoors.

Although Spiders are a very positive essential to nature's paradigm, our little housemates tend to incite more fear than favour and even provoking phobias for some. It's true that here in Sanctuary Lakes we do have some venomous spiders, but the Australian spider's reputation is bigger than its bite: The last death in April 2016 was the country's first recorded spider-caused death since 1981. From personnel experience, I can confirm that spiders can give you a nip, but in most cases it's less troublesome than a bee sting.

All that said, it is still worthwhile taking a close look at four spiders who are probably living or entering your property at this moment. And also discover how these eight-legged arthropods were given their legendary name Arachnid.

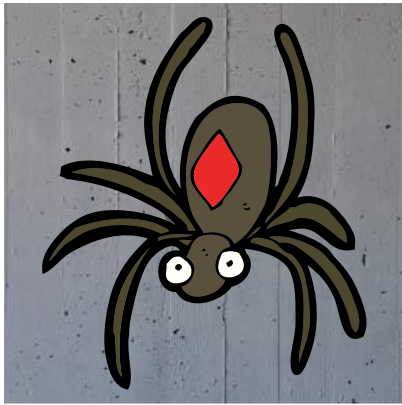

Four common spiders in Sanctuary Lakes are:

- The Redback Spider
- The White-tailed Spider
- The Huntsman Spider
- Daddy Long Legs



Humans have always lived with spiders and they are symbolic characters in many of our myths and legends. For example, the word Arachnid, for spider and Arachnophobia, fear of spiders, comes from Greek mythology story of Arachne. Arachne, was a beautiful woman who had a great talent in weaving. Everyone was amazed at her work and one day, Arachne boasted that she had a greater talent than goddess Athena herself. This was an offense towards the gods, which was a very serious and even deadly sin for the ancient Greeks. As punishment Athena transformed her into a spider to spend the rest of her life weaving webs.
