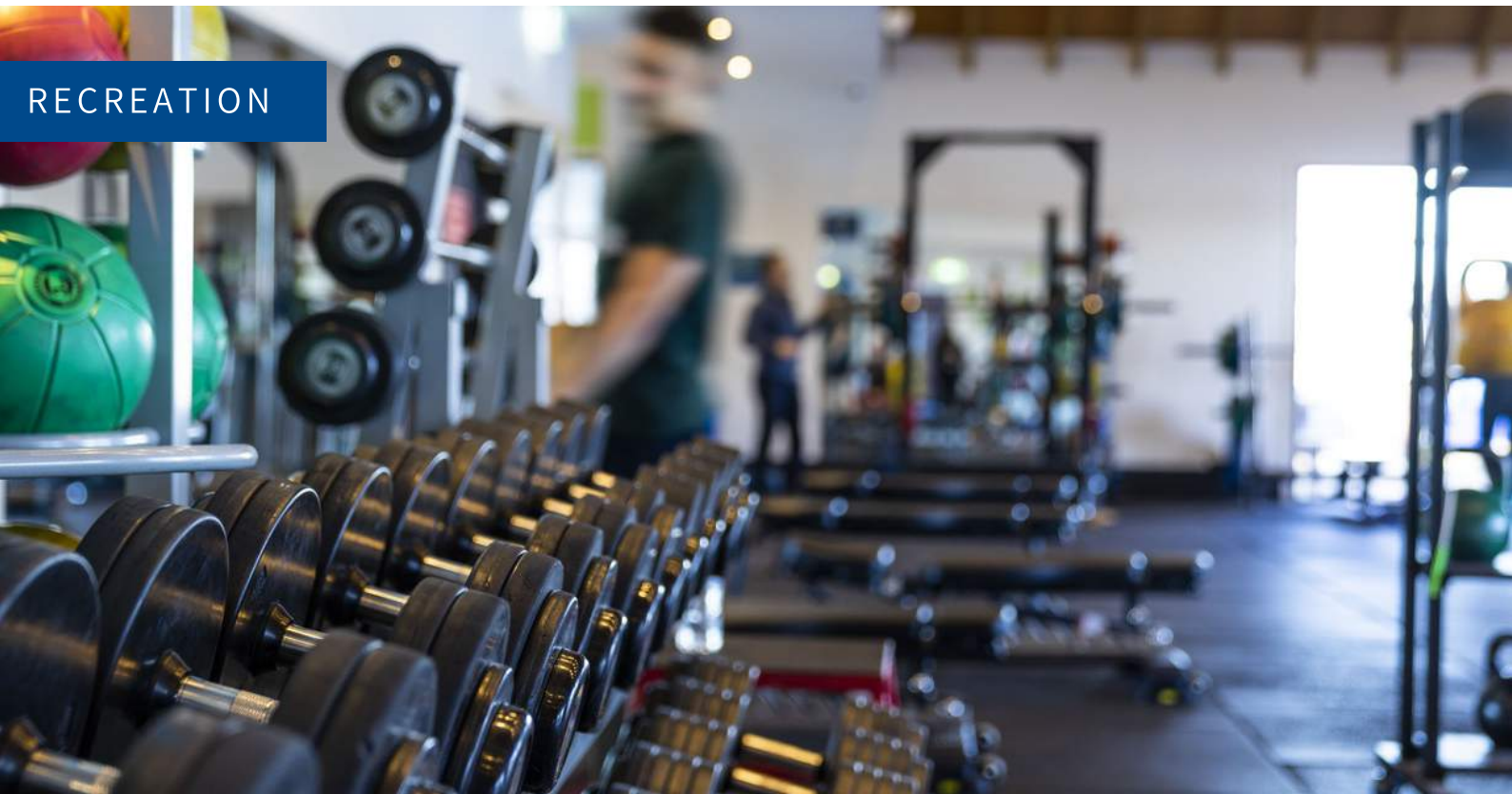


LOST AND FOUND

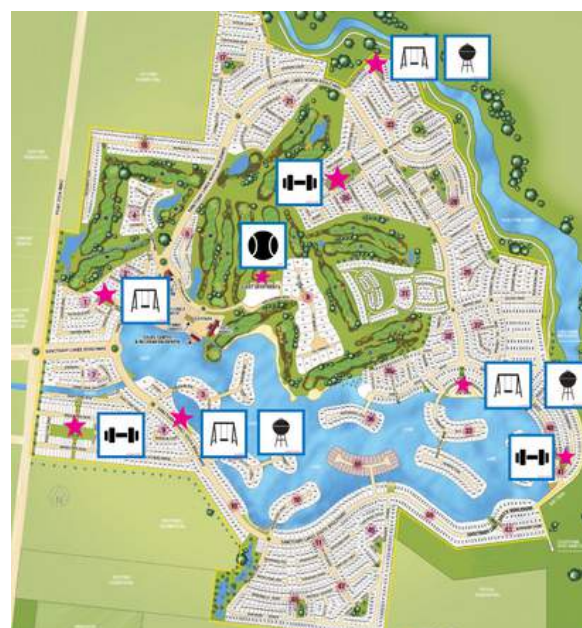

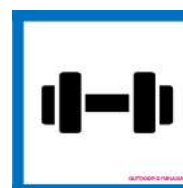

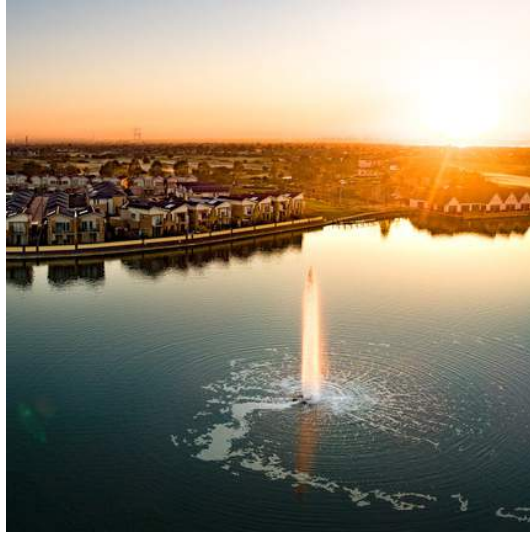

Irrigation Works

The irrigation system has recently undertaken a major upgrade. This upgrade aims to ensure water pressure is consistent throughout the Resort.

New irrigation lines were also installed in previously non-irrigated areas, such as on Sanctuary Lakes Boulevard. Nature strips that had new lines installed will be re-turfed by Resort Maintenance.

Re-rendering Works

Each year a section of the wall on Sanctuary Lakes Boulevard is re-rendered to fix damage, surface cracks, and enhance the overall appearance of the wall section.

The latest section of wall to be re-rendered will be on Sanctuary Lakes Boulevard North from Lot S to the Gleneagles entry.

This will take place from September to mid-November.
