

NBN ROLLOUT UPDATE

We are pleased to announce that the nbn Fibre to the Curb (FTTC) rollout will cover all of Sanctuary Lakes, including gated stages. Areas that currently have only Clublinks Telco fibre will also have nbn fibres laid.

The rollout will begin in early June 2018 and is scheduled for completion by October 2018. We anticipate the network will be ready for connections in early 2019.

In order for the FTTC to be correctly installed, technicians are required to undertake works within Sanctuary Lakes. These works will allow homes to be connected to the underground nbn Distribution Point Units via fibre cables, through the existing copper network. The nature of these works means that there will be some nature strip damage, including the possibility of pit lid size increases. Fulton Hogan, the rollout partner of nbn, will be responsible for all rollout works as well as any necessary reinstatement works.

Residents should also be aware that nbn fibres will be laid within the existing copper network pipes and pits. Although nbn will allow residents to access faster and more reliable broadband, it also means that most residents will also need to move both their current internet service and home phone across to the new network once it is activated.

Residents that have medical alarm devices should check their device compatibility with the new network, and they are encouraged to register their device at: nbn.com.au/medicalregister They should also be aware that once the nbn is connected to their homes that any equipment connected over the nbn access network will not work during a power outage. Priority Assistance nbn customers are also required to have a battery backup for their nbn devices.



The existing copper network is due to be switched off mid 2020. This will affect our back-to-base monitoring system and we are currently exploring internet based, as well as mobile SIM card based solutions to this issue. Once a viable solution is found, we will contact residents with the details.

NATURE'S RUBIK

OUR FAVOURITE NATIVE GARDEN BIRDS

There are three native birds that seem to visit almost every garden in Sanctuary Lakes; the New Holland Honeyeater, the Willie Wagtail, and the White Plumed Honeyeater. Although there are similarities in this trio, there are also fascinating differences.

The New Holland Honeyeater was the very first Australian bird to be scientifically described by European ornithologists and can extend its tongue around 10 times per second to drink nectar from flowers. While the cheeky Willie Wagtail has been attributed to many legends within Aboriginal tribes, usually pair with other wagtails for life, and are known for their nocturnal call. Finally, the White-plumed Honeyeater who could be mistaken for a common house sparrow from a distance; until you focus on its yellowish-olive head, slightly down-curved beak and distinctive white neck plume. Like the New Holland Honeyeater, the White-plume is similarly efficient at drinking nectar.




GOLF CLUB TRIVIA NIGHT
